





Indoor Department: The total bed strength of the Charitable Hospital is **300**.

The private ward patients are also offered the same services free except the medicines and nominal room charge. A total number of 24,866 patients were treated at the in-door department during the year 2021-22.

- Children Ward: As in previous years, a very generous donor from Mumbai provided the necessary financial support for free treatment to all patients in the 19-bed children ward. This year 2667 children got admitted for free treatment in this ward whereas 23,169 children got consultation in the OPD. Bed, diet and medicines were provided free to all the patients.
- Alternative Medicine and Clinics: The Sevashrama offers Ayurveda, Homeopathy and Naturopathy ways of alternative treatments on a regular basis.
- Emergency Department: This department funtions 24x7 with Nine Medical Officers, one Consultant Gynaecologist, one Cancer Surgeon, two Physicians and one Cardiologist. 40,238 patients visited the department during 2021-22.
- Rural Mobile Medical Service: A team comprising 2 doctors, 2 nurses, 1 attendant and 2 volunteers continue to provide medical services in the rural areas of Mathura District four days a week. All the patients are given 6 days medicines free of cost. The total number of patients treated was 25,847. This year, due to Covid-19 pandemic, Rural Mobile Medical Service was done on days except the lockdown period. The Mobile Medical Vans used for this service are donated by Blind Foundation for India, USA and IOCL, Mathura.
- COVID Services: In view of the upsurge in the number of COVID patients during the second wave of the pandemic, the hospital started a COVID wing with COVID RT-PCR Trunat testing and in-patient treatment. During this year, 6900 COVID tests were done, 2070 patients were treated in Emergency and 699 patients were treated in the different Isolation wards of the hospital.
- **Blood Bank:** Apart from exchange donors from patients' side, different groups of voluntary donors donated the life-saving blood throughout the year. We are very grateful to the **Rakta Data Foundation**, **Vrindavan** for supplying blood to our patients whenever required. A total of **1,860** transfusions took place at the hospital this year.



- The new (40th) batch of **30 meritorious students** from economically backward families from 10 states were admitted to the 3 years General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) course recognised by the Indian Nursing Council, Delhi and the U.P. State Medical Faculty. All the students are provided board & lodging free of cost.
- Nursing School students, with the guidance of their teachers, imparted health education and conducted awareness & counselling programmes as a part of their Community Training Programme in baby care, food & nutrition, hygiene, sanitation, post immuni-zations and HIV/AIDS.
- Lamp Lighting Ceremony: The Lamp Lighting Ceremony was held with due pomp and éclat in the Swami Vivekananda Auditorium on 22nd December, 2021. Swami Atmashraddhananda Maharaj, Secretary of Ramakrishna Mission, Kanpur, presided over the function whereas Dr. (Smt.) Jyoti Bala, Dean, U.P.U.M.S. Govt. Nursing College, SAIFAI (Etawah) and Sri Pradeep Gaur, Chairman & Managing Director, Rail Vikas Nigam Limited, New Delhi were the Guest-of-Honor. The same evening, the School celebrated its Annual Day with various cultural programmes. Scholarships sponsored by Revered Swami Suviranandaji Maharaj in the name of Revered Swami Nirvananandaji Maharaj were distributed to outstanding nursing students.

General Relief & Welfare programmes

Welfare of Widow Mothers & the poor: We extend warm gratitude to Paramahamsa Yogananda Public Charitable Trust, New Delhi towards the fullfree medical treatment for the destitute widow mothers, sadhus, poor menwomen-children of Vrindavan and its adjacent places. All of them are given fullfree treatment in our Charitable Hospital which include doctors' consultations, medicines, investigations, in-patient services including surgeries. We have continued distributing food materials such as rice, wheat flour, pulses, sugar, salt, tea, milk powder, cooking oil, soap etc. needed for one month to 1600 poor widows every month by their courtesy.

Apart from this, a blanket, a saree, 1 ltr. edible oil, two soaps and a pair of socks were distributed to 1700 poor widows on the sacred Birthday of Holy Mother Sri Sarada Devi. 300 Sadhus were provided Dhoti & Towel along with Pranami on the sacred Birthday of Sri Ramakrishna Paramahamsa. About 850 more widow mothers were given food ration on the Holy Akshaya Tritiya, Akshaya Navami, Pitri Amavasya and few other days. All this was possible with the aid and support of Paramahamsa Yogananda Public Charitable Trust, New Delhi, Smt. Mohini Devi Somani & Family, Delhi, Manav Seva Sansthan, Mumbai, Ramakrishna Mission Headquarters, Belur Math and other generous donors.

- Assistance to the underprivileged was rendered in the form of educational aid, school dress and books; socks to the poor in winter; monetary help for marriages, sari & dhoti, medicines, blankets; rickshaw fare to the poor patients and widow mothers; cremation expenses, etc. to the tune of ₹ 1,10,99,271/during the year to 22,100 beneficiaries. Total 412 spectacles were provided to the Widow Mothers and Sadhus by the courtesy of Sri R.G. Agrawal, Dhanuka Agritech Ltd., New Delhi.
- Scholarships worth ₹ 2,71,530/- were distributed to 101 meritorious students belonging to various schools in Vrindavan.
- **TB patients & Physically challenged :** We have provided food grains ration along with TB medicines to **50** TB patients and physically challenged persons.
 - Distribution of Blankets & Clothing: Apart from that given to the widow mothers of Vrindaban on the occasion of Holy Mother's Birthday, another 750 blankets, 400 pairs of socks & 440 woolycot (full sleeves) were distributed to the poor of different remote villages of Brajdham, including the poor on the streets of Vrindaban, during the winter with the kind donation of Sri Baidyanath Ayurvedic Bhawan, Nagpur, Adv. Anita Sahani, Delhi, Dr. Anup Mallik & Dr. Abhijit Mukherjee, West Bengal and other generous donors. Bundles of clothing (old and new) were distributed to many other poor people in remote villages all through the year.
 - Bal Vikas Kendra: Two units of non-formal school, one at Panighat (Old Ashrama) and another at Shyamanagar were conducted with the aim of promoting physical, mental and spiritual development of children. More than 200 children took part in both these units. The main activities included regular tuition classes, group prayer, cultural activities and games. Children were given soaked pulses, biscuits, bananas, apples, bread, bun, milk with protein powder along with the seasonal fruits alternatively. School bags, school uniforms, bathing-soap, washing powder, coconut oil, tooth brush, and tooth paste, note books, etc. were also given to the children. Our heartfelt gratitude to the AICL via Headquarters, Belur Math and NEC Technologies India Pvt. Ltd., Noida for their continued support to provide nutritious food and other utility materials to all the children of these two units.
- Child Eye Sight Project: With the help of contribution from Blind foundation for India, USA free medicines and eye drops were given to 8,050 children and 40 spectacles were also distributed.

Other Activities

- Guest House: Accommodation was provided to a few hundred devotees, wellwishers, visiting doctors and patrons who came as pilgrims to Vrindaban from different parts of India and even from abroad.
- Goshala: A goshala with more than 110 cows serve the patients, nursing students & staff, doctors and other staff of the Sevashrama with milk throughout the year.

Spiritual & Cultural

- Ma Sarada Kutir (formerly known as Kala Babu Kunj): The Ninth anniversary of the Ma Sarada Kutir was celebrated on 12th September 2021 with Special Puja, Havan and bhajans. Following the Covid-19 pandemic norms, a few Sadhus and devotees participated in the day-long celebration.
- Temple: Daily worship, bhajans, weekly readings from the Gospel of Sri Ramakrishna in Hindi, celebration of holy birthdays of Direct Disciples of Sri Ramakrishna and other great spiritual teachers, Janmashtami, Kali Puja, Durga Puja, Shiva Ratri, Christmas etc. were conducted in the temple with due solemnity and devotional fervour. Many local devotees and those from other places joyfully participated in these celebrations.
- Library and Book Sales Section: Continued to serve the local people and visiting devotees by making available Ramakrishna-Vivekananda and Vedanta literature.
- **Sri Sarada Devi Birthday:** The 169th Birthday of Sri Sri Sarada Devi, was observed on 26th December, 2021. The celebration started in the auspicious early hours at 5.30 am with Mangalarati. Special puja was performed at 8am followed by havan, Chandi recital and devotional songs. Many sadhus, devotees and admirers participated in the above events with great joy and devotion. 'Rogi Narayan Puja' was performed with devotion at 10.00 am at the indoor department of the Hospital worshipping each and every patients with sandal paste, garland, Arati and offerings of fruits and sweets by sadhus, devotees and students & staff nurses. At 12 noon, as part of Narayan Seva, in all about 3100 widow mothers, poor men, women and children, devotees and others were sumptuously fed with noon prasad. Like every year on this auspicious occassion, 1700 widow mothers were given a gift pack consisting of a Blanket, a saree, one bottle mustard oil, two soaps and a pair of socks.
- Swami Vivekananda Birthday: The 160th Birthday of Srimat Swami Vivekananda was celebrated with devotion and festivities on 25th January, 2022. The celebration started at 5.30 am in the Temple with Mangalarati followed by chanting of Vedic mantras. This was followed by special puja, recital of Bhagavad Gita, reading from the life and teachings of Swami Vivekananda, Bhajan, Kirtans and Rogi Narayan Puja in the hospital indoor department. In all about 900 Nara Narayan and devotees were served noon prasad.
- **Sri Ramakrishna Dev Birthday :** The 187th Birthday of Sri Ramakrishna Dev was celebrated with various programmes on 04th March, 2022. Special Puja, Havan, bhajans and kirtans, recital of Chandi, feeding of the poor and Rogi Narayan puja etc. were held on that day. 300 Sadhus and Vaishnavas were served Prasad and given cloth and dakshina on this occasion. In all about, 900 devotees were served noon prasad.
